ORDINANCE OF THE CHIEF PLEAS

ENTITLED

THE DEPUTIES OF THE PEOPLE (GENERAL ELECTION)

(SARK) ORDINANCE, 1996.

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section twelve of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, hereby order:-

Date fixed for General Election.

1. (1) The date for the General Election, for the office of Deputy of the People to be held in December, nineteen hundred and ninety six, shall be Tuesday the tenth day of that month.

(2) Where at the said General Election, two or more candidates secure an equal number of votes and the addition of one vote to his or her poll would have entitled any such candidate to be declared elected, a further election shall be held on Tuesday the seventh day of January, nineteen hundred and ninety seven, in respect of such candidates only, without further nomination, in pursuance of the provisions of section five of the Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinance, 1952, as amended.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deputies of the People (General Election) (Sark) Ordinance 1996.
