Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

Entitled

The Deputies of the People (General Election)(Sark) Ordinance, 2002

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section twelve of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, hereby order:

1. (1) The date for the General Election, for the Office of Deputy of the People to be held in December, two thousand and two, shall be Wednesday the eleventh day of that month.

(2) Where at the said General Election, two or more candidates secure an equal number of votes and the addition of one vote to his or her poll would have entitled any such candidate to be declared elected, a further election shall be held on Wednesday the eighth day of January two thousand and three, in respect of such candidates only, without further nomination, in pursuance of the provisions of section five of the Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinance, 1952, as amended.

Citation 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deputies of the People (General Election)(Sark) Ordinance, 2002.
