| Date fixed for General Election. | 1. | <p>(1) The date for the General Election, for the Office of Deputy of the People to be held in December, two thousand and five, shall be held on Wednesday the seventh day of that month.</p> <p>(2) Where at the said General Election, two or more candidates secure an equal number of votes and the addition of one vote to his or her poll would have entitled any such candidate to be declared elected, a further election shall be held on Wednesday the eleventh day of January two thousand and six, in respect of such candidates only, without further nomination, in pursuance of the provisions of section five of the Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinance, 1952, as amended.</p> |
