

Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

entitled

The Deputies of the People (General Election) Ordinance, 1975

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section twelve of the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, hereby order:-

Date fixed
for General
Election

1. (1) The date for the General Election for the office of Deputy of the People to be held in December, nineteen hundred and seventy-five, shall be Friday, the nineteenth day of that month.

(2) Where, at the said General Election, two or more candidates secure an equal number of votes and the addition of one vote to his poll would have entitled any such candidate to be declared elected, a further election shall be held on Saturday, the third day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-six, in respect of such candidates only, without further nomination, in pursuance of the provisions of section five of the Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinance, 1952, as amended.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Deputies of the People (General Election) Ordinance, 1975.
