**The Destructive Insects and Pests
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1981**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, hereby order:—

1. At the end of Article seven of the Destructive Insects and Pests Ordinance of 1936, as amended^(a), there are hereby inserted the following additional words—

“and the Court by whom the person is convicted shall, in addition, have power to authorise an Inspector to seize, destroy or otherwise dispose of any insect of a non-indigenous species or of any plant to which the conviction relates at the expense of the convicted person”.

Extent. 2. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Destructive Insects and Pests (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981.
