**The Doctors, Dentists and Veterinary
Surgeons (Authorisation) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1984**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States
Advisory and Finance Committee, hereby order:—

1. In section 5 of the Doctors, Dentists, Veterinary Surgeons (Authorisation) Ordinance, 1951, as amended^(a), (hereinafter called “the principal Ordinance”) the words “in the case of a first conviction to a fine not exceeding twenty pounds and in the case of a second or subsequent conviction to a fine not exceeding fifty pounds” are repealed and the words “on conviction to a fine not exceeding five hundred pounds” are substituted therefor.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Doctors, Dentists and Veterinary Surgeons (Authorisation) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1984.
