

Ordinance of the Chief Pleas

The Fishing (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1973

THE CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK, in pursuance of their Resolution of the seventeenth day of July, nineteen hundred and seventy-two hereby order:-

Amendment to Ordinance of 1958.

1. Immediately after section seven of the Fishing (Sark) Ordinance, 1958, as amended, there is inserted the following section numbered "7A" -

" 7A.(1) A person shall not place or leave a pot intended or adapted for use for taking fish of any kind in the territorial waters of this Island during the period commencing on the first day of November in each year and ending on the thirty-first day of March next following, both days inclusive.

(2) Any person who contravenes or attempts to contravene the provisions of subsection (1) of this section shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to a fine not exceeding ten pounds or imprisonment for a term not exceeding one month or both, and the Court may, in addition thereto, order the seizure, destruction or other disposal of the pot to which the conviction relates, and of any equipment or apparatus used in connection with such pot, and of any fish found therein, or any of them, at the expense of the convicted person.

(3) The Constable or the Vingtenier may open, inspect and seize any pot which he has reasonable cause to believe has been placed or left in contravention of the provisions of subsection (1) of this section or may inspect and seize any fish found therein, or both."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fishing (Amendment) (Sark) Ordinance, 1973.

may be cited together as the Fishing (Sark) Ordinances, 1958 to 1973.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-fifth  
day of April , nineteen hundred and seventy-three.
