Ordinance of the States **XXIX**

1970

Made 27th May, 1970.
Came into Operation 27th May, 1970.

The Fishing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy, hereby order:—

1. The Fishing Ordinance, 1969 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a), is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) in subsection (1) of section eleven thereof immediately after the word “take” there are inserted the words “lobsters, crawfish, crabs, escallops or”;
- (b) subsection (2) of section eleven thereof is repealed and the following subsection is substituted therefor—

“(2) A person who, on surfacing after having been totally or partially submerged and breathing with the aid of submarine breathing apparatus or wearing a diving suit, a face visor, a mask or goggles in any of the

said parts of the said territorial waters, is found to have in his possession any lobsters, crawfish, crabs, scallops or ormers shall be deemed to have contravened the provisions of subsection (1) of this section unless he can prove either:—

- (a) that he did not take the lobsters, crawfish, crabs, scallops or ormers while he was totally or partially submerged; or
- (b) if he took only lobsters, crawfish or crabs, that—
 - (i) he did not take the lobsters, crawfish or crabs otherwise than while using an apparatus known as “a snorkel”, and
 - (ii) he took the lobsters, crawfish or crabs for consumption only by himself or a member of his household.”;
- (c) in the heading to the Third Schedule thereto immediately after the word “for” there are inserted the words “lobsters, crawfish, crabs, scallops and”;
- (d) paragraph 3 of the Third Schedule thereto is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor—

“ 3. Between an imaginary line drawn due north from Fort Doyle, in the parish of the Vale, and an imaginary line drawn from the Belvedere Light through the Castle Breakwater Light, in the parish of Saint Peter Port, and produced in a north-easterly direction to a point where it meets the limits of the territorial waters adjacent to this Island.”.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fishing Citation,
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1970.

3. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance Collective
may be cited together as the Fishing Ordinances, title.
1969 and 1970.
