Ordinance of the States **XXXIX**

1977

Made **15th December, 1977.**

The Fishing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-ninth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, hereby order:—

1. The Fishing Ordinance, 1969, as amended^(a), is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) in section thirteen thereof—

(i) subsection (1) is repealed and the following subsection is substituted therefor—

“ (1) A person shall not deposit in any part of the territorial waters adjacent to this Island or on the foreshore of this Island any molluscan shellfish taken either—

(a) from any shellfish bed outside the aforesaid territorial waters or foreshore; or

(b) from any shellfish bed in any area within the aforesaid territorial waters or foreshore as the Committee may, from time to time, by order prescribe where the Committee is satisfied that for the purposes of preventing the spread of disease or pests carried by shellfish it is expedient to make such order;

otherwise than under and in accordance with a licence granted to such person by the Committee under the provisions of this section.”;

(ii) immediately after subsection (3) there is inserted the following additional subsection numbered “(4)”—

“ (4) The provisions of subsection (2) of the last preceding section with respect to the making of orders shall apply to every order made under paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section.”;

(b) in subsection (1) of section sixteen thereof the definition of the expression “shellfish bed” is repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor—

“ “shellfish bed” means any bed or ground in which shellfish are usually found or which is used for the propagation or cultivation of shellfish;”;

(c) in the First Schedule thereto—

(i) immediately after the entry relating to the item “Crabs, commonly known as “lady crabs”” there are inserted respectively in the first column thereof

the following additional items and opposite thereto in the second column thereof the following entries relating thereto—

“Crabs,
commonly
known as
“spider
crabs”

A carapace length of twelve centimetres, being the length measured from between the two horns to the rear end of the body shell along the centre line of the body shell

Lobsters

A carapace length of eight centimetres, being the length measured from the rear of either eye socket to the rear end of the body shell along a line parallel to the centre line of the body shell”;

- (ii) in the first column thereof the entry relating to the item “Crawfish or lobsters” is deleted and the entry “Crawfish” is substituted therefor.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fishing Citation.

3. This Ordinance and the Fishing Ordinances Collective
1969 to 1976, may be cited together as the Fishing title.
