# Ordinance of the States **XXX**

**1981**

Made ... .. 9th December, 1981.  
Coming into Operation ... 1st January, 1982.

## **The Fishing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of October, nineteen hundred and eighty-one, hereby order:—

1. Subsection (1) of section five of the Fishing Ordinance, 1969, as amended(*a*), is hereby repealed and the following subsection is hereby substituted therefor—

“(1) A person shall not take, have in his possession, buy, sell or offer for sale in this Island any ormers, other than preserved ormers, at any time except on the day of each new moon and of each full moon and on the two days immediately following the day of each new moon and of each full moon during the period commencing on the first day of January

in each year and ending on the thirtieth day of April next following, both dates inclusive: Provided that any person found to be in possession of, or buying, selling or offering for sale, ormers on the first or second day of May or on the third or fourth day next following the day of a new moon or of a full moon during the period specified in this subsection shall be deemed not to have contravened the provisions of this sub-section if that person is able to prove that those ormers were not taken after the thirtieth day of April or after the second day next following the day of the new moon or of the full moon as aforesaid, as the case may be."

**Citation.**

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fishing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1981.

**Collective title.**

3. This Ordinance and the Fishing Ordinances, 1969 to 1979, may be cited together as the Fishing Ordinances, 1969 to 1981.

**Commencement.**

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.
