**The Fishing (Amendment) Ordinance,
1988**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of October, 1987, hereby order:—

1. Immediately after section 13A of the Fishing Ordinance, 1969, as amended^(a), there is hereby inserted the following additional section numbered “13B”

to Ordinance
of 1969.

“Control of landing of fish for reasons of conservation.” 13B. (1) Where the Committee is satisfied that for the purposes of compliance with conservation regulations in force within British fishery limits it is expedient so to do, the Committee may, from time to time, by order prohibit the landing in this Island of fish of any kind as shall be specified in such order.

(2) The provisions of section 12(2) of this Ordinance with respect to the making of orders shall apply to every order made under this section.”.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fishing (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988.

Collective title. 3. This Ordinance and the Fishing Ordinances, 1969 to 1987, may be cited together as the Fishing Ordinances, 1969 to 1988.
