The Fishing (Exemption) Ordinance, 1961

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and upon the representations of the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries, hereby order:—

1. Nothing in the Fishing Ordinance, 1955 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) contained shall be taken to apply to a servant or agent of the States Committee for Agriculture and Fisheries when acting for or on behalf of that Committee. Committee not bound by principal Ordinance.
2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Fishing (Exemption) Ordinance, 1961, and this Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Fishing Ordinances, 1955 and 1961. Citation and collective title.
