THE FISHING (REGULATION OF TRAWLING)
(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1999

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 10th day of November, 1999, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 46 of the Government of Alderney Law, 1987, as amended (a), hereby order:—

1. (1) Where any vessel-

- (a) the engine power of which exceeds 150 horsepower, fishes or attempts to fish by trawling within that part of Alderney waters not exceeding 1 international nautical mile from the baselines from which the breadth of those waters is measured;
- (b) the engine power of which exceeds 300 horsepower, fishes or attempts to fish by trawling within that part of Alderney waters lying between 1 and 3 international nautical miles from the said baselines;

the master, owner and charterer (if any) of the vessel shall each be guilty of an offence.

(2) A person guilty of an offence under subsection (1) shall be liable on conviction to a fine not exceeding level 5 on the Alderney uniform scale.

Interpretation.

2. (1) In this Ordinance "Alderney waters" means the waters which, on the date of the commencement of this Ordinance, comprise the territorial waters adjacent to Alderney and its dependencies.

(2) The provisions of the Interpretation (Guernsey) Law, 1948(b) shall apply to the interpretation of this Ordinance.

Citation.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as The Fishing (Regulation of Trawling) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1999.

Commencement.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 10th November 1999.
