**The Flower Transport (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1972**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by paragraph (3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948(a), by section four of the Flower Transport (Guernsey) Law, 1971(b), and on the representations of the States Committee for Horticulture, hereby order:—

1. Section seventy-six of the Flower Transport Ordinance, 1971(c), is hereby repealed and the following section is hereby substituted therefor—

“76. This Ordinance shall come into force on the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and seventy-two:

(b) No. XII of 1971.
(c) No. LIX of 1971.

Provided that the power conferred by section sixty-six of this Ordinance on the Committee to make any order may be exercised at any time before the said thirtieth day of September subject, however, to the restriction that any such order shall not come into force until the said thirtieth day of September.”.

Citation. 2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Flower Transport (Amendment) Ordinance, 1972.
