**The Food and Drugs (Certificate of
Analysis) Ordinance, 1973**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Health and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (4) of section twenty-seven of the Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970(a), hereby order:—

1. The form of certificate set out in the Schedule to this Ordinance is hereby prescribed as the form in which a certificate shall be given by the States Analyst under the provisions of subsection (4) of section twenty-seven of the Law. Certificate of Analysis.

2. (1) In this Ordinance the expression "the Law" means the Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970, and any other expressions have the same meanings as in the Law. Interpretation.

(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall, except where the context otherwise

requires, be construed as including a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed or replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment including this Ordinance.

Extent. 3. This Ordinance shall have effect in the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Citation. 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Food and Drugs (Certificate of Analysis) Ordinance, 1973.

SCHEDULE Section one

Form of Certificate to be given by the States Analyst under the provisions of subsection (4) of section twenty-seven of the Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970

Notes

- (1) Insert the name and address of the person originally submitting the sample for analysis.
- (2) Insert particulars of marking, e.g. date, number, etc.
- (3) This may be left unanswered if the sample cannot be conveniently weighed or measured, or the weight or measurement is not material to the result of the analysis.
- (4) Here the States Analyst should specify the result of the analysis in the light of the provisions of the Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970.
- (5) Here the States Analyst may insert at his discretion his opinion whether the analysis indicates any addition, abstraction, or deficiency or the presence of foreign matter or other defect and whether the nature, substance or quality is thereby affected; any physical, chemical or other properties bearing on the nature, substance or quality of the article; whether the article is injurious to health or unfit for human consumption; whether and in what respect a label or description or any advertisement relating to the sample is incorrect or misleading; and he may add any other observations he may consider relevant.
