**The Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law,
1970 (Commencement) Ordinance, 1976**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (2) of section fifty-six of the Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. Section fifty-five of the Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970, in so far as that section repeals the Law entitled “Loi ayant rapport aux Préservatifs et autres substances dans les Aliments” registered on the twenty-third day of February, nineteen hundred and twenty-nine(b), shall come into force on the twenty-sixth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-six.

Commencement of certain provisions of the Law of 1970.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Food and Drugs (Guernsey) Law, 1970 (Commencement) Ordinance, 1976.
