ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 3rd April, 1991
Coming into force 4th April, 1991

THE FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE (AMENDMENT)
(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1991

THE STATES, pursuant to their Resolution of 3rd April, 1991 and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Section 46 of, and paragraph (a) of Schedule 2 to, the Government of Alderney Law, 1987(a), hereby order:-

Amendment to Ordinance of 1952

1. For the Schedule to the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) Ordinance, 1952 there is substituted:

6 months to 1 year	£200
under 6 months	£150

4. An ox, aged	
2 years or more	£500
1½ to 2 years	£325
1 to 1½ years	£250
6 months to 1 year	£200
under 6 months	£150"

Repeals and saving

2.(1) The Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1968, the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974 and the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1982 are repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding Section 1 of this Ordinance and subsection (1) of this section, the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1982 shall continue to apply in the case of any animal slaughtered under and in accordance with the provisions of the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) Ordinance, 1952 before 4th April, 1991.

Citation

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Foot and Mouth Disease (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1991.

Collective title

4. This Ordinance and the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) Ordinance, 1952 may be cited together as the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) Ordinances, 1952 and 1991.

Commencement

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on 4th April, 1991.
