**The Foot and Mouth and other Animal  
Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, 1982**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of June, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, hereby order:—

1. The Foot and Mouth Disease Ordinance, 1950, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a), is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) subsection (2) of section ten thereof is repealed and the following subsection is substituted therefor—

“ (2) The compensation payable, in respect of any animal slaughtered under and in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be—

(a) in the case of cattle, other than oxen, their market value immediately before slaughter or the amount specified hereunder for the category of animal in question, whichever is the less—

(i) a milch cow, or a heifer  
over six months in calf £600;

(ii) a heifer aged—  
two years and over and  
which is less than six  
months in calf ... .. £400  
two years and over and  
which is not in calf ... £300  
one and a half years  
and under two years ... £260  
one year and under one  
and a half years ... £200  
six months and under  
one year ... .. £170  
under six months ... £150;

(iii) a bull aged—  
two and a half years  
and over ... .. £600  
two years and under  
two and a half years ... £400  
one and a half years  
and under two years ... £260  
one year and under one  
and a half years ... £200  
six months and under  
one year ... .. £170  
under six months ... £150:

Provided that the compensation in the case of a bull whose slaughter is considered by the Committee (from whose decision an appeal shall lie to the Royal Court) to be necessary as the result of that bull being or having been kept at a breeding centre shall be its market value immediately before slaughter; and for the purposes of this proviso the expression "breeding centre" means—

- (a) a place at which a bull is kept for the purpose of taking to it a cow or a heifer for breeding in accordance with the provisions of subsection (5) of section six of this Ordinance; and
- (b) a place at which a bull is kept for the purpose of collecting from it semen for artificially inseminating bovine animals under the control and direction of the Committee;
- (b) in the case of a sheep, twenty-eight pounds or its market value immediately before slaughter, whichever is the less;
- (c) in the case of a goat, fifty pounds or its market value immediately before slaughter, whichever is the less;

- (d) in the case of any other ruminating animal, its value as meat;
  - (e) in the case of a breeding sow or boar, one hundred and fifty pounds or its market value immediately before slaughter, whichever is the less;
  - (f) in the case of any other swine weighing under one hundred pounds, ten pounds for the first month of age of the swine with an additional eight pounds for each subsequent month of age thereof or its market value immediately before slaughter, whichever is the less;
  - (g) in the case of any other swine weighing one hundred pounds or over, its value as meat.”;
- (b) in section thirteen thereof the words “one hundred pounds” are repealed and the words “five hundred pounds” are substituted therefor.

Compensation in respect of animal slaughtered before the coming into force of this Ordinance.

2. In the case of an animal slaughtered under the provisions of the principal Ordinance before the coming into force of this Ordinance and in respect of which compensation in accordance with the provisions of that Ordinance has not been paid at the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance, compensation shall be payable in respect of that animal as if this Ordinance had not been passed.

3. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with Construction.  
the principal Ordinance.

4. This Ordinance shall apply to the Islands of Extent.  
Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Foot and Citation.  
Mouth and other Animal Diseases (Amendment)  
Ordinance, 1982.

6. This Ordinance and the Animal Diseases Collective  
Ordinances, 1950 to 1978, may be cited together as title.  
the Animal Diseases Ordinances, 1950 to 1982.
