The Foot and Mouth and other Animal Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988

THE STATES, on the Representations of the States Agricultural and Milk Marketing Board, hereby order:—

1. In the Second Schedule to the Foot and Mouth Disease Ordinance, 1950, as amended (a), after “Sheep Scab or Psoroptic Mange,” there is inserted:—

Amendment to Ordinance of 1950.

“Bovine Spongiform Encephalopathy”.

2. This Ordinance shall apply to the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou.

Extent.

3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Foot and Mouth and other Animal Diseases (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988.
