ORDINANCE OF THE STATES

Made 4th September, 1974
Coming into force 4th September, 1974

THE FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE (ALDERNEY)
(AMENDMENT) ORDINANCE, 1974

THE STATES on the representation of the States Agricultural and States Dairy Committee hereby order:

1. The Schedule to the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) Ordinance, 1952, shall be further amended as follows:

"A milch cow" for £120 substitute £180

"A heifer aged -
2 years and over for £120 substitute £180
1½ years and under 2 years for £ 80 substitute £100
1 year and under 1½ years for £ 50 substitute £ 80
6 months and under 1 year for £ 30 substitute £ 50
under 6 months" for £ 30 substitute £ 50

"A bull aged -
2½ years and over for £150 substitute £200
2 years and under 2½ years for £120 substitute £150
1½ years and under 2 years for £ 60 substitute £ 80
1 year and under 1½ years for £ 50 substitute £ 70
6 months and under 1 year for £ 40 substitute £ 50
under six months" for £ 30 substitute £ 40

"An ox aged -
2½ years and over for £ 75 substitute £100
1 year and under 2½ years for £ 60 substitute £ 80
6 months and under 1 year for £ 25 substitute £ 40
under six months" for £ 25 substitute £ 30

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Foot and Mouth Disease (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1974, and shall come into effect on 4th September, 1974.

Water by measure for domestic use.

3. The rate referred to in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section fourteen of the Law for the supply of water by measure to any property for domestic use shall be as follows:-

- (a) until and including Midsummer Day, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, 35p. per thousand gallons;
- (b) from and including the day next following Midsummer Day, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, 46p. per thousand gallons.

Water by measure for other than domestic premises.

4. The rate referred to in paragraph (b) of subsection (2) of section fourteen of the Law for the supply of water by measure for other than domestic purposes shall be as follows:-

- (a) until and including Midsummer Day, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, 35p per thousand gallons;
- (b) from and including the day next following Midsummer Day, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, 46p per thousand gallons.

Water for glasshouses.

5. The charge referred to in paragraph (a) of subsection (3) of section fourteen of the Law for the supply of water for other than domestic purposes shall in respect of glass houses be calculated at the rate of 75p. per hundred feet by thirty feet of glasshouse or proportionately thereof.

Citation.

6. This Ordinance may be cited as the States Water Supply (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1974.

Commencement.

7. This Ordinance shall come into force on the fifth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.
