(No. XIII— The Foot and Mouth Disease (Amendment No. 2)
1952)
Ordinance, 1952.

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE,
under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon
them by paragraph (3) of Article Sixty-six of the
Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and in pursuance of
the Resolution of the States of the 18th day of June,
1952, hereby order:

Breeding and
transfer of
animals.

1. Immediately after subsection (3) of section six
of the Foot and Mouth Disease Ordinances, 1950 and
1952, there is hereby inserted the following additional
subsections: —

“(4) Upon the revocation of an order made under
subsection (1) of this section, the Board may, subject
to the provisions of the next succeeding subsection,
by order from time to time declare that in respect
of the Islands of Guernsey, Herm and Jethou or
any part of them—

(a) the taking of an animal to another animal
for breeding is prohibited, and

(b) the delivery in connection with the transfer by sale or otherwise of an animal is prohibited except under the authority of a permit issued by, and under such conditions as may be imposed by, the Board.

(5) Nothing in the last preceding subsection shall apply to—

(a) the taking of an animal to another animal for breeding when both animals are on the same farm ;

(b) the taking of a cow or heifer to a bull or the taking of a sheep, goat or other ruminating animal, or swine to another animal of that species for breeding under the authority of a permit issued by, and under such conditions as may be imposed by, the Board.

2. This Ordinance and the Foot and Mouth Disease Ordinances, 1950 and 1952, shall be construed together and this Ordinance and those Ordinances may be cited together as the Foot and Mouth Disease Ordinances, 1950 to 1952. Construction and citation.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 19th day of June, 1952. Commencement.
