Ordinance of the States. **XXXIV**

Made 6th December, 1950
Coming into Operation 7th December, 1950

**The Fowl Pest Amendment Ordinance,
1950.**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 11th day of October, 1950, hereby order:—

1. Section 11 of the Fowl Pest Ordinances, 1949, is hereby amended by the addition, at the end thereof, of a new sub-section, as follows—

“(5) No compensation shall be payable under this section if the Board finds that the owner of the slaughtered poultry is, by reason of his negligence or default, responsible for his poultry becoming infected with fowl pest:

PROVIDED that an appeal shall lie to the Royal Court from any decision of the Board under this sub-section.”

2. This Ordinance and the Fowl Pest Ordinances, 1949, may be cited together as the Fowl Pest Ordinances, 1949 and 1950.

3. As from the date of the coming into force of this Ordinance the provisions of the Fowl Pest Ordinances, 1949 and 1950, shall apply to the Islands of Herm and Jethou as they apply to the Island of Guernsey.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 7th day of December, 1950.
