**The Gambling (Betting) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1988**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Gambling (Guernsey) Law, 1971, as amended(*a*), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of January, 1988, hereby order:—

1. For paragraph 5 of Schedule 1 of the Gambling (Betting) Ordinance, 1973, as amended(*b*), substitute the following:— Amend-

“ 5. (1) Apparatus for making information or other material available in the form of sounds or visual images or both shall be permitted in a licensed betting office, subject to the condition that the information or other material provided in this way shall be about a sporting event or coverage thereof, including:—

- (a) information relating to betting or to any sporting event in which betting transactions may be or have been effected;
- (b) the results of any such event;
and
- (c) any matter incidental to such an event or to such coverage.

(2) The apparatus for receiving visual images in a licensed betting office shall include a screen. Any such screen shall not:—

- (a) exceed 30 inches in width; or
- (b) be so positioned so that it can be seen from outside the licensed premises, whether through a window or otherwise.

(3) Apparatus for receiving any visual images shall not be used in a licensed betting office if:—

- (a) the service by means of which such images appear is not intended to be received by the general public or other licensees generally;
or
- (b) in the case of video recordings, identical recordings of the same event are not available to other licensees generally.

(4) No music, dancing or other entertainment shall be provided or allowed in a licensed betting office and no refreshments of any kind shall be served to persons resorting to a licensed betting office.

(5) The provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to a licensed credit betting office.”.

2. Any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by any other enactment including this Ordinance. Interpreta-
tion.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling (Betting) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1988. Citation,

(2) This Ordinance and the Gambling (Betting) Ordinances, 1973 and 1985 may be cited together as the Gambling (Betting) Ordinances, 1973 to 1988.
