

The Gambling (Betting) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1995

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolutions of the 28th June, 1995^a, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Gambling (Guernsey) Law, 1971, as amended^b, hereby order:-

No gambling on National Lottery.

1. In section 18(1) of the Gambling (Betting) Ordinance, 1973, as amended^c insert the following paragraph after paragraph (e)-

"(f) the Committee is satisfied that the applicant or any employee of his has, since the licence was last granted or renewed, received or negotiated a bet on the outcome of any lottery (including, without prejudice to the generality of the foregoing, a lottery forming part of the National Lottery for the purposes of Part I of the National Lottery etc. Act 1993^d).".
