

The Gambling (Betting) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1999

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 28th day of October, 1998^a, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Gambling (Guernsey) Law, 1971, as amended^b, hereby order:-

Amendments to Ordinance of 1973.

1. The Gambling (Betting) Ordinance, 1973, as amended^c, is further amended as follows-

- (a) in paragraph 1 of the First Schedule, for "A licensed betting office" substitute "Subject to paragraph 1A, a licensed betting office";
- (b) immediately after paragraph 1 of the First Schedule, insert the following additional paragraph-

"1A. (1) Notwithstanding paragraph 1 of this Schedule-

- (a) a licensed credit betting office, or
- (b) a licensed betting office operating only as a licensed credit betting office,

may be open and used for, or in connection with, the effecting of betting transactions on any Sunday (other than Christmas Day) during such hours between nine in the morning and ten in the evening as may be prescribed.

(2) Sub-paragraph (1) of this paragraph does not permit a bookmaker's authorised agent to effect betting transactions at his authorised place on any Sunday."; and

- (c) immediately after paragraph 8 of the Second Schedule, insert the following additional paragraph-

"9. A person to whom an authority has been issued shall not throughout every Sunday, Good Friday and Christmas Day and at such other times as may be prescribed receive or negotiate bets at his authorised place."

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling (Betting) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1999.
