**The Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery)
(Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment)
Ordinance, 1977**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the Gambling (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Law, 1974(a), and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975(b), is hereby amended as follows:— Amend-

(a) subsection (5) of section four thereof shall be deleted and the following subsection shall be substituted therefor—

“ (5) Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this section, the Committee may,

if it considers it expedient or necessary to do so, cause every ticket and, where a ticket is divisible into parts, every part of every ticket purchased by the Committee from the Jersey Committee for sale to agents in the Bailiwick of Guernsey in respect of a particular draw to be marked in such manner as the Committee may, from time to time, prescribe.”;

- (b) immediately after subsection (9) of section six thereof there shall be inserted the following subsection—

“ (10) The foregoing provisions of this section shall have effect in respect of any draw held in the Bailiwick of Guernsey.”;

- (c) in subsection (7) of section eight thereof the words “nothing in this paragraph” are deleted and the words “nothing in this subsection” are substituted therefor;

- (d) sub-paragraph (iii) of paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of section ten thereof shall be deleted and the following sub-paragraphs shall be substituted therefor—

“(iii) in any draw in respect of which the Committee, in accordance with the provisions of subsection (5) of section four of this Ordinance, has decided that every ticket purchased by the Committee from the Jersey Committee for sale to agents in the Bailiwick of Guernsey should be marked, a ticket or a part of a ticket which is not so marked; or

- (iv) in any draw in respect of which the Committee has decided not to mark

the tickets so purchased by the Committee for sale to agents in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, a ticket or a part of a ticket bearing a serial number other than the serial number of a ticket sold by the Committee to an agent;”;

- (e) in subsection (2) of section ten thereof the words and figures “sub-paragraphs (ii) and (iii)” are deleted and the words and figures “sub-paragraphs (ii), (iii) and (iv)” are substituted therefor.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977, and this Ordinance and the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975, may be cited together as the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinances, 1975 and 1977.
