Ordinance of the States **XI**

1975

Made 30th April, 1975.
Coming into Operation ... 16th May, 1975.

The Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the first day of March, nineteen hundred and seventy-three, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section two of the Gambling (Guernsey) Law, 1971(a), hereby order:—

1. Participation in the Channel Islands Lottery shall not be unlawful gambling.

Participation in Channel Islands Lottery not unlawful gambling.

2. (1) In this Ordinance the expression "the Channel Islands Lottery" has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section one of the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975(b).

Interpretation.

(2) Any reference in this Ordinance to any other enactment shall be construed as a reference to that

enactment as amended, repealed and replaced, extended or applied by or under any other enactment, including this Ordinance.

Repeal of

3. The Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1973(c), is hereby repealed but without prejudice to the payment of prizes in the public lotteries held thereunder.

Amend
ments.

4. (1) The Gambling (Gaming and Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971(d), is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) in subsection (1) of section five and in subsection (1) of section six thereof the words and figures “a public lottery within the meaning of the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971,” are repealed and the words “the Channel Islands Lottery,” are substituted therefor;

(b) in subsection (1) of section seventeen thereof there is inserted, immediately before the definition of the expression “class” the following definition—

“the Channel Islands Lottery” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section one of the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975;”;

(c) in paragraph (a) of subsection (2) of section eighteen thereof the words and figures “the Gambling (Public Lotteries) Ordinance, 1971,” are repealed and the words and figures “the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975,” are substituted therefor.

(2) Subsection (1) of section thirty-eight of the Gambling (Betting) Ordinance, 1973(e), is hereby amended as follows:—

- (a) immediately after the definition of the expression “bookmaker’s occasional licence” there is inserted the following definition—

““the Channel Islands Lottery” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section one of the Channel Islands Lottery (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975;”;

- (b) the definition of the expression “public lottery” is repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor—

““public lottery” means the Channel Islands Lottery, and any reference to a public lottery shall be construed accordingly;”;

- (c) the definition of the expression “ticket” is repealed and the following definition is substituted therefor—

““ticket” has the meaning assigned to it by subsection (1) of section eleven of the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Bailiwick of Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975;”.

5. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling (Channel Islands Lottery) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1975, and shall come into force on the sixteenth day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-five.
