

The Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1997

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 26th day of February, 1997^a, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 2 of the Gambling (Guernsey) Law, 1971, as amended^b, hereby order:-

Amendments to 1983 Ordinance.

1. The Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983, as amended^c, is further amended as follows-

- (a) in section 2(a)-
 - (i) at the end of sub-paragraph (ii), delete "and";
 - (ii) immediately after sub-paragraph (iii), insert the following-

"and
 - (iv) other events held principally out of doors, where-
 - (aa) the event includes participation in, or support of, sports, games or cultural activities, or
 - (bb) the main objective of the event is to raise proceeds which are devoted to

purposes other than purposes of private gain;"

- (b) in section 4(3)(b), for "ten o'clock" substitute "eleven o'clock"; and
- (c) in section 16(2), for "fifty pounds" substitute "level 3 on the uniform scale".

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Amendment) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1997.
