

The Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1999

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 25th day of February, 1999^a, hereby order:-

Crown and Anchor permitted on Liberation Day, 1999.

1. By way of exception to section 4(3) of the Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983, as amended^b, the States Gambling Control Committee may, under the provisions of that Ordinance, grant a table permit which shall have effect on Sunday, 9th May, 1999 in respect of any period between 12 noon and 11 p.m.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1999.
