The Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1999

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 25th day of February, 1999^a, hereby order: –

Crown and Anchor permitted on Liberation Day, 1999.

1. By way of exception to section 4(3) of the Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983, as amended^b, the States [Committee for Home Affairs] may, under the provisions of that Ordinance, grant a table permit which shall have effect on Sunday, 9th May, 1999 in respect of any period between 12 noon and 11 p.m.

NOTES

In section 1, the words in square brackets were substituted by the Organisation of States' Affairs (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2016, section 2, Schedule 1, paragraph 6(a), with effect from 1st May, 2016.¹

The functions, rights and liabilities of the Home Department and its Minister arising under or by virtue of this Ordinance were transferred to and vested in, respectively, the Committee for Home Affairs and its President or Vice-President by the Organisation of States' Affairs (Transfer of Functions) Ordinance, 2016, section 1, Schedule 1, paragraph 6(a), with effect from 1st May, 2016, subject to the savings and transitional provisions in section 3 of the 2016 Ordinance.²

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling (Crown and Anchor) (Liberation Day) Ordinance, 1999.
