THE GAMBLING (EXEMPTED LOTTERIES) (ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1994

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by sections 1 and 2 of the Gambling (Alderney) Law, 1975(a), hereby order:—

1. (1) The forms of gambling specified in subsection (2) are hereby declared to be lawful for the purposes of sections 1 and 2 of the Gambling (Alderney) Law, 1975. **Exempted lotteries.**

(2) The forms of gambling referred to in subsection (1) are raffles, draws and lotteries promoted by or for and on behalf of—

(a) any charity entered in the Register of Charities established and maintained under section 4 of the Charities Act 1960(b) or excepted from such registration under section 4(4) of that Act;

(b) any properly constituted club or organisation formed in the Island of Alderney;

provided that in each case—

(i) all proceeds of the raffle, draw or lottery (other than the bare expenses of conducting it and the cost or amount of the prize or winnings) are given solely for the purposes of the charity, club or organisation; and

(ii) no part of the said proceeds goes by way of commission, reward or other profit.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Gambling (Exempted Lotteries) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1994.
