

The Gambling (Gaming and Lotteries) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1999

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the 27th day of May, 1999^a, and in exercise of the powers conferred by section 2 of the Gambling (Guernsey) Law, 1971, as amended^b, hereby order:-

Amendments to Ordinance of 1991.

1. The Gambling (Gaming and Lotteries) Ordinance, 1991^c, is amended as follows-

- (a) in the proviso to section 6(1)-
 - (i) for "£1" substitute "£5"; and
 - (ii) for "£8,000" substitute "£20,000";
- (b) in section 6(3)(c), immediately after "Class III" insert "or Class IV";
- (c) in section 8(a), for "£800" substitute "£1,000";
- (d) in section 8(b), for "£4,000" substitute "£5,000";
- (e) in section 8(c), for "£8,000" substitute "£10,000";
- (f) immediately after section 8(c) insert a semi-colon and the following paragraph-

- "(d) Class IV, being lotteries other than Classes I, II or III, where the price of a ticket or chance is more than £1 and does not exceed £5 and in which no prize exceeds £20,000 in value";
- (g) immediately after section 9(1)(c) insert a semi-colon and the following paragraph-
 - "(d) for promoting a Class IV lottery, £100";
- (h) in section 11(2)(b)-
 - (i) for "50 pence" substitute "£1"; and
 - (ii) for "£80" substitute "£100".
