The Glasshouse (Prescribed Maximum Area) Ordinance 1950.

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Committee for Horticulture, under and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by section three of The Glasshouse Control Law, 1936, hereby order:—

1. During the period commencing on the 17th day of May, 1950, and ending on the 30th day of April, 1951, the prescribed maximum area in force for the purposes of section three of the Law shall be determined in accordance with the following provisions of this section—

- (a) in the case of a person who is not the owner of any glasshouse in the Island of Guernsey, the prescribed maximum area shall be 9,000 square feet;
- (b) in the case of a person who is the owner of glasshouses covering an area of less than 4,500 square feet in the Island of Guernsey, the prescribed maximum area shall be an area equal to the difference between the area owned and 9,000 square feet;

- (c) in the case of a person who is the owner of glasshouses of an area of 4,500 square feet or more in the Island of Guernsey, the prescribed maximum area shall be 4,500 square feet;
- (d) a person who has a valid permit to erect any glasshouse from the Committee under the provisions of the Law shall be deemed, for the purposes of this Ordinance, to be the owner of a glasshouse of the area specified in any such permit:

PROVIDED that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to a permit granted under section five of the Law for erection in replacement of an existing glasshouse, until that glasshouse is demolished.

2. Nothing in the preceding section contained shall prevent the renewal by the Committee of a permit granted to any person under the provisions of subsection (2) of section six of the Law before the coming into force of this Ordinance.

3. The following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them—

“Committee” means the States Committee for Horticulture;

“glasshouse” has the same meaning as in the Law;

“person” includes a person corporate or incorporate together with any person corporate in which the first mentioned person has a preponderating financial interest; and

“the Law” means The Glasshouse Control Law, 1936.

4. The Ordinance entitled The Glasshouse (Prescribed Maximum Area) Ordinance, 1939, is hereby repealed.

5. This Ordinance shall come into force on the 17th day of May, 1950.
