Ordinance of the States **XXVII**

1967

Made 31st May, 1967
Deemed to have come into Operation .. 1st May, 1967

The Glasshouse (Prescribed Maximum Area) Ordinance, 1967

THE STATES, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon them by section three of the Glasshouse Control Law, 1936, as amended(*a*), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-sixth day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, hereby order:—

1. On and after the commencement of this Ordinance the prescribed maximum area in force for the purposes of the Glasshouse Control Laws, 1936 to 1961(*a*), shall be the area specified in the Schedule to this Ordinance.

Prescribed maximum area.

2. During the operation of this Ordinance the operation of the Glasshouse Control (Prohibition and Prescribed Maximum Area) Ordinance, 1961(*b*), is hereby suspended.

Ordinance of 1961 suspended.

3. The Glasshouse (Prescribed Maximum Area) Ordinance, 1966(*c*), is hereby repealed.

Citation. 4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Glasshouse (Prescribed Maximum Area) Ordinance, 1967.

Duration. 5. This Ordinance shall be deemed to have come into force on the first day of May, nineteen hundred and sixty-seven, and shall cease to have effect on the thirtieth day of April, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

SCHEDULE Section one

The Prescribed Maximum Area = 30,000 square feet.
