**The Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board
(Elections) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1953.**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE, in pursuance of paragraph (3) of Article 66 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, and of the Tomato Marketing (Guernsey) Law, 1952, and on the representations of the States Committee for Horticulture, hereby order:—

1. In the application of the provisions of the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board (Elections) Ordinance, 1953 (hereafter in this Ordinance referred to as “the principal Ordinance”) to the first election of members of the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board, paragraph (d) of subsection (2) of section thirteen (which relates to voting papers) shall have effect and shall be deemed always to have had effect as though the words “and other particulars” were omitted.

2. This Ordinance shall be construed as one with the principal Ordinance.

3. This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Guernsey Tomato Marketing Board (Elections) Ordinances, 1953.
