## Ordinance of the States **XXIII**

1977

Made ... .. 25th May, 1977.  
Coming into Operation ... 1st June, 1977.

### **The Harbour Dues (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (3) of section three and section six of the Harbour Dues (Saint Peter Port and Saint Sampson) Law, 1957, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-eighth day of April, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, hereby order:—

1. In the right hand column of Part II of the Schedule to the Harbour Dues (Saint Peter Port and Saint Sampson) Law, 1957, as amended<sup>(a)</sup> (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Law”), immediately after the figures and letter “25p” there are hereby inserted the following words—

“Provided that the dues chargeable under this category may be reduced or waived, at the discretion of the Board, in respect of any

passenger who has not attained the age of fifteen years landed from or embarked on a vessel if the Board is satisfied that that passenger has been or is about to be conveyed in that vessel at zero or at a reduced fare.”.

Refund of dues.

2. The Board shall refund to the owner of a vessel an amount equal to the difference between the amount of the harbour dues under Part II of the Schedule to the principal Law paid by such owner during the period commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, and ending on the thirty-first day of May, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, and the amount of the harbour dues under Part II of the said Schedule which would have been paid by such owner during the said period if Part II of the said Schedule as amended by the last preceding section had been in force throughout the said period.

Citation and collective title.

3. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Harbour Dues (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977.

(2) This Ordinance and the Harbour Dues (No. 2) Ordinance, 1976, may be cited together as the Harbour Dues Ordinances, 1976 and 1977.

Commence-ment.

4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven.
