The Harbour Dues (No. 2) Ordinance, 1959

THE STATES, under and by virtue of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (3) of section three of the Harbour Dues (Saint Peter Port and Saint Sampson) Law, 1957, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the sixteenth day of September, nineteen hundred and fifty-nine, hereby order:—

1. Harbour Dues payable under the provisions of section three of the Harbour Dues (Saint Peter Port and Saint Sampson) Law, 1957, shall be deemed not to have been payable by the owners of the vessels set out in the left-hand column of the Schedule to this Ordinance during the periods set out in relation to those vessels respectively in the right-hand column of that Schedule.

2. Section two of the Harbour Dues Ordinance, 1959, is hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance, the Harbour Dues Ordinance, 1958, and the Harbour Dues Ordinance, 1959, may be cited together as the Harbour Dues Ordinances, 1958 to 1959.
