**THE HARBOUR DUES INCREASE (AMENDMENT)**  
**(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1987**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 5 of the Harbour Dues, Fees and Charges (Alderney) Law, 1984(a) and in pursuance of their Resolution of the third day of June, 1987, hereby order:-

**Rate of Harbour dues.**

1. For the First Schedule to the Harbour Dues, Fees and Charges (Alderney) Law, 1984 as amended there is substituted the Schedule set out in Schedule 1 to this Ordinance.

**Rate of additional dues.**

2. For the Second Schedule to the Harbour Dues, Fees and Charges (Alderney) Law, 1984 there is substituted the Schedules set out in Schedule 2 to this Ordinance.

**Repeal.**

3. The Harbour Dues Increase (Alderney) Ordinance, 1987(b) is repealed.

**Citation.**

4. This Ordinance may be cited as the Harbour Dues Increase (Amendment) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1987.

**Commencement.**

5. This Ordinance should come into force on the third day of June, 1987.

**Harbour dues – vessels**

## PART II

### Passenger Fees

PASSENGER	RATE PER PASSENGER
Passengers landed or embarked from or for a place outside a radius of fifty-five nautical miles from Braye Harbour, other than passengers landed or embarked from or on a cruise vessel.	75p Provided that the fee may be reduced or waived at the discretion of the Committee in respect of any passenger who has not attained the age of fifteen years if the Committee is satisfied that the passenger has been or is about to be conveyed at zero or at a reduced fare.
Passengers landed or embarked from or for a place at or within a radius of fifty-five nautical miles from Braye Harbour, other than passengers landed or embarked from or on a cruise vessel.	51.5p Provided that the fee may be reduced or waived at the discretion of the Committee in respect of any passenger who has not attained the age of fifteen years if the Committee is satisfied that the passenger has been or is about to be conveyed at zero or at a reduced fare.

#### Calculation of harbour dues and passenger fees

In calculating the amount of any harbour dues or passenger fees payable under this Law, in any case where the aggregate amount payable is not a multiple of a whole new penny the amount payable shall be taken to the nearest whole new penny below.

#### Definition of Cruise vessel

In this Part of this Schedule the expression "cruise vessel" means a vessel which enters a harbour or the roadstead solely for the purpose of enabling passengers thereon to visit the Island as part of the itinerary of a cruise or for the purposes of embarking or disembarking passengers beginning or ending a cruise in the vessel, and does not occupy a berth.
