The Harbour Dues Ordinance, 1982

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the twenty-fifth day of February, nineteen hundred and eighty-two, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by subsection (3) of section three and section six of the Harbour Dues (Saint Peter Port and Saint Sampson) Law, 1957, hereby order:—

1. The entries relating to harbour dues of Category C set out in the second and third columns of Part I of the Schedule to the Harbour Dues (Saint Peter Port and Saint Sampson) Law, 1957, as amended^(a), are hereby repealed and the entries set out in the following columns are hereby respectively substituted therefor—

Citation and collective title.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Harbour Dues Ordinance, 1982.

(2) This Ordinance and the Harbour Dues Ordinances, 1976 and 1980, may be cited together as the Harbour Dues Ordinances, 1976 to 1982.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of April, nineteen hundred and eighty-two.
