## Ordinance of the States **XXXVII**

1977

Made ... .. 15th December, 1977.  
Coming into Operation ... 1st January, 1978.

### **The Harbour Facilities (Charges) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977**

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of the first day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-seven, hereby order:—

1. The Schedule to the Harbour Facilities (Charges) Ordinance, 1976 (hereinafter referred to as “the principal Ordinance”)(a), is hereby amended as follows:—

(a) the first paragraph of *Scale A* thereof is repealed and the following paragraph is substituted therefor—

“*Tonnage or vehicle rate*

- (b) *Scale B* thereof is repealed and the following Scale is substituted therefor—

“*Scale B: Hourly rate*

Provided that under this Scale a minimum period of one hour shall be chargeable.”;

- (c) item (a) of *Scale C* thereof is repealed and the following item is substituted therefor—

- “(a) All goods other than boats £3.45 per lift not exceeding 7 metric tons plus £1.70 per metric ton in excess of 7 metric tons:

Provided that the maximum amount chargeable under this item of this Scale shall be £8.00 per lift.”.

Citation and collective title.

2. (1) This Ordinance may be cited as the Harbour Facilities (Charges) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1977.

(2) This Ordinance and the principal Ordinance may be cited together as the Harbour Facilities (Charges) Ordinances, 1976 and 1977.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and seventy-eight. <sup>Commence-</sup>
