**The Harbours (Entry and Exit)
(Amendment) Ordinance, 1956.**

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Board of Administration, hereby order:—

1. The Harbours (Entry and Exit) Ordinance, 1952, as amended, is hereby further amended as follows:—

(a) section 2, as amended, is numbered as section 2 (1) and the following subsection is added thereto:—

“(2) During such times as the signals referred to in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section are displayed or exhibited, the Master or Pilot of a vessel shall not cause or attempt to cause that vessel to leave its berth, mooring or anchorage in the said Harbour except with the permission of the States Harbourmaster.”;

(b) section 3 is numbered as section 3 (1) and the following subsection is added thereto:—

“(2) During such times as the signals referred to in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) of this section are displayed or exhibited, the Master or Pilot of a vessel shall not cause or attempt to cause that vessel to leave its berth, mooring or anchorage in the said Harbour except with the permission of the States Harbourmaster.”.

2. This Ordinance and the Harbours (Entry and Exit) Ordinances, 1952 and 1955, may be cited together as the Harbours (Entry and Exit) Ordinances, 1952 to 1956.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the first day of October, 1956.
