The Eggs (Increase in Fines) Ordinance, 1983

THE STATES, on the representations of the States Committee for Agriculture, hereby order:—

1. In Article 9 of the Ordinance entitled “Ordonnance relative au Marquage d’Oeufs” made on the twenty-fourth day of October, nineteen hundred and thirty-six, as amended^(a), the words “five pounds” and “ten pounds” are repealed and the words “fifty pounds” and “one hundred pounds” are respectively substituted therefor. Amendment to Ordinance of 1936.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Eggs (Increase in Fines) Ordinance, 1983. Citation.

3. This Ordinance and the Eggs Ordinances, 1936 and 1969, may be cited together as the Eggs Ordinances, 1936 to 1983. Collective title.
