**The Election Expenditure (Guernsey)
Ordinance, 1973**

THE STATES LEGISLATION COMMITTEE,
in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by
paragraph (1) of Article forty-four and paragraph
(3) of Article sixty-six of the Reform (Guernsey)
Law, 1948, as amended, hereby order:—

1. In relation to an election for the office of
People's Deputy a candidate shall not, during the
period of twenty-eight days immediately preceding
the date fixed by Ordinance made under the pro-
visions of paragraph (3) of Article twenty-nine of
the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended^(a),
for the holding of that election, expend any sum
of money or give any value in money's worth in
excess of the amount specified in the right hand
column of the Schedule to this Ordinance in relation
to each of the Electoral Districts specified in the
left hand column of that Schedule.

Repeal. 2. The Electoral Expenditure Ordinance, 1948(b),
is hereby repealed.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Election
Expenditure (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1973.
