

Ordinance of the Chief Pleas of Sark

The Election of Deputies (Sark) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970

The CHIEF PLEAS OF SARK under and by virtue of the powers conferred on them by the Reform (Sark) Law, 1951, hereby order:-

1. The Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinance, 1952, is hereby amended as follows:-

- (a) Article 5 by deleting the words "as soon as conveniently may be" and substituting therefor the words "on the date appointed therefor" and by inserting after the word "only" the words "without further nomination".
- (b) Article 6(3) by deleting the word "on" and substituting therefor the words "not later than".
- (c) Article 8(2) by (i) deleting the reference to "the 17th day of October" and substituting "the 31st day of October", and  
(ii) deleting the word "consecutive".

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Election of Deputies (Sark) (Amendment) Ordinance, 1970 and this Ordinance and the Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinance, 1952, may be cited together as the Election of Deputies (Sark) Ordinances, 1952 and 1970.

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the *eleventh* day of *November*, nineteen hundred and seventy.
