The Electoral Expenditure (Constables and Douzeniers) Ordinance, 1988

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Article 44(1) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended^(a), as applied to elections to the offices of Constables and Douzeniers by Article 53 thereof, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the 9th day of December, 1987, hereby order:—

1. In relation to an election for the office of Constable or Douzenier, as the case may be, a candidate shall not, during the period commencing on the fourteenth day immediately preceding the date fixed by announcement in the "Gazette Officielle" given pursuant to Article 55 of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended (hereinafter

referred to as “the Law”), for the holding of that election and ending on the date fixed as aforesaid for the holding of that election, both day and date inclusive, expend any sum of money or give any value in money’s worth in excess of the amount specified in the right hand column of the Schedule to this Ordinance in relation to each of the Parishes specified in the left hand column of that Schedule: Provided that where at any such election a secret ballot is demanded in accordance with Article 59(1) of the Law, the period specified in this section shall be extended to the period ending on and including the date fixed by announcement in the “Gazette Officielle” given pursuant to Article 59(3) of the Law for the holding of that secret ballot.

Repeal. 2. The Electoral Expenditure (Constables and Douzeniers) Ordinance, 1986(b), is hereby repealed.

Citation. 3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Electoral Expenditure (Constables and Douzeniers) Ordinance, 1988.
