**The Electoral Expenditure Ordinance, 1985**

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by Article 44(1) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended<sup>(a)</sup>, and in pursuance of their Resolution of the 31st day of October, 1984, hereby order:—

1. In relation to an election for the office of <sup>Election</sup> People's Deputy a candidate shall not, during the <sup>expenses.</sup> period of twenty-eight days immediately preceding the date fixed by Ordinance made under the provisions of Article 29(3) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, as amended, for the holding of that election, expend any sum of money or give any value in money's worth in excess of the amount specified in the right hand column of the Schedule to this Ordinance in relation to each of the Electoral Districts specified in the left hand column of that Schedule.
