

The Electoral Roll Ordinance, 1999

THE STATES, in pursuance of their Resolution of 27th May, 1999¹ and in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Article 34(1) and the proviso to Article 27(1)(e) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948², hereby order:-

General revision of Electoral Roll

1. The year 1999 is hereby specified for the purposes of Article 34(1) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948.

Continued entitlement to inscription on Electoral Roll

2. For the purposes of the proviso to Article 27(1)(e) of the Reform (Guernsey) Law, 1948, it is hereby declared that a person who is entitled to be inscribed on the Electoral Roll for the electoral year commencing 1st March, 2000 is, if he fulfils the conditions of Article 27(1)(b), (c) and (d) of that Law, entitled to be inscribed on the Electoral Rolls for the electoral years commencing 1st March, 2001, 1st March, 2002 and 1st March, 2003.
