The Electricity (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983

THE STATES, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section one of the Electricity (Modification) (Guernsey) Law, 1955(a), and in pursuance of their Resolution of the thirtieth day of November, nineteen hundred and eighty-three, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, hereby order:—

1. The provisions of section thirty-one of the Law entitled “Loi relative à la Fourniture de l'Electricité par les Etats, 1933”(b) shall, during the period commencing on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and eighty-four, and ending on the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and eighty-four, be varied by the substitution for the requirements with respect to any electrical installation fixed or placed in any premises to which electrical energy is or is about to be supplied by the States Electricity Board (hereinafter referred to as “the Board”) of

the requirement that any electrical installation fixed or placed in any premises to which energy is or is about to be supplied by the Board shall not be used after it has been fixed or placed as aforesaid unless and until such installation has been examined, tested and approved by an inspector authorised by the Board in that behalf as complying with the requirements of the Institution of Electrical Engineers of London as set forth in either the fourteenth Edition or the fifteenth Edition of the rules and regulations for the electrical equipment of buildings issued by that Institution.

Citation.

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Electricity (Guernsey) Ordinance, 1983.
