The Electricity Concession (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2008

THE STATES OF ALDERNEY, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 31 of the Alderney Electricity Concession Law, 1953, as amended (a) hereby order:—

1. The maximum charge for the supply of electricity to a consumer, as indicated by meter, which the Company shall be entitled to make in respect of the quarters ending 25th March, the 24th June, the 29th September and the 25th December in each year shall be 50 pence for each unit consumed. **Increase in charge for the supply of electricity.**
2. The Electricity Concession (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 2008 is hereby repealed. **Repeal.**
3. This Ordinance may be cited as the Electricity Concession (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) (Amendment) Ordinance, 2008. **Citation.**
4. This Ordinance shall come into force on the eighth day of June 2008. **Commencement.**
