**THE ELECTRICITY CONCESSION (RATES OF CHARGE)**  
**(ALDERNEY) ORDINANCE, 1974**

**THE STATES**, in pursuance of their Resolution of the fifth day of June, nineteen hundred and seventy-four, and in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section thirty-one of the Alderney Electricity Concession Law, 1953, as amended (a), hereby order:-

**Increase in charges for the supply of electricity.**

1. The charges for the supply of electricity to a consumer which the Company shall be entitled to make -

- (a) under paragraph (a) (ii) of section thirty-one of the Alderney Electricity Law, 1953, as amended, in respect of the quarters ending the 25<sup>th</sup> March and the 25<sup>th</sup> December in each year shall be a sum not exceeding 7.5p for each unit over and above fifteen units; and
- (b) under paragraph (b) (ii) of the said section thirty-one in respect of the quarters ending the 24<sup>th</sup> June and the 29<sup>th</sup> September in each year shall be a sum not exceeding 7.5p for each unit over and above ten units.

**Citation.**

2. This Ordinance may be cited as the Electricity Concession (Rates of Charge) (Alderney) Ordinance, 1974.

**Commencement.**

3. This Ordinance shall come into force on the twenty-sixth day of December, nineteen hundred and seventy-four.
